IN THE LEGISLATURE

2021

Passed Act 322 creating a 3-year lookback window for CSA claims. Effective June 14, 2021, to June 14, 2024.

2022

Passed Act 386 clarifying its intent to revive all CSA claims against any party. Effective June 10, 2022.

May 2024

Passed Concurrent Resolution declaring its explicit intent to eliminate the SOL for CSA claims & criticizing the LA Supreme Court

June 2024

Passed SB246 extending the "lookback" window

"lookback" window by an additional 3 years until June 14, 2027.

IN THE COURTROOM



The LA state Governor did not sign SB246 before it became law. As a result, the new window extension will not take effect until

AUGUST 1ST 2024



MARCH 22, 2024

4–3 ruling by the LA Supreme Court declaring the window unconstitutional under Article II of the state constitution.



MAY 10, 2024

5-2 decision by the LA Supreme Court granting rehearing on its March 22nd ruling.



JUNE 12, 2024

5-2 decision by the LA Supreme Court reversing its earlier decision & declaring the window constitutional. Justices Scott Crichton & Piper Griffin, part of the majority in March, joined Chief Justice John Weimer & justices Jay McCallum & William Crain to revive the law.
