- Disclose Facts of Sex Abuse Epidemic to Public
- Arm Parents to Protect Children
- Shift Cost of Abuse from Victim to Those Who Caused It
- JUSTICE FOR VICTIMS READY TO COME FORWARD

Number of Lawsuits Filed when a Time-Limited Window was Open




Chart Summary: The number of cases is modest overall, and the states that have experimented with reviving only the SOL against the perpetrator (and not institutions) have yielded an extremely small number of cases.

CALIFORNIA (Calendar Year 2003)

California (2003) (1-year window)

- Population: 39.54 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Approximately 1,150 = .002% of population
- Predators identified: 300+
- Entities sued: Boy Scouts, Catholic Church, The Explorers (Los Angeles Police Department), family members, Monterey Bay Academy, The Salvation Army, The Seventh-Day Adventist Church
- Entities/Predators Identified since 2003 Window Closed: Jason Michael Handy, LA United School District, Jehovah's Witnesses, Hollywood Film Industry, Palo Alto Medical Foundation, Dominican Hospital, Fusion Health Care and Silhouette Medspa, Vungle, USA Water Polo, The International Water Polo Club, Iglesia La Familia De Dios
- False claims: Anecdotal reports of handful – none reported in courts

CONNECTICUT (2010)

Connecticut (2010 into the future) (revives expired claims to age 48)

- Population: 3.59 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Revival of expired civil SOLs is ongoing (up to age cap)
- Predators identified: Windsor Copeland, Joseph Dabrow, Donald Dennis, Rabbi Daniel Greer, Fr. Paul Hebert, Fr. Daniel McSheffery, Dr. George Reardon, Christopher Simmonds, Dr. Harold Spalter, Ty Treddenbarger
- Entities sued: Archdiocese of Hartford, Boy Scouts, Diocese of Norwich, The Gan School, Indian Mountain School, Inc., Yeshiva of New Haven, Diocese of Bridgeport, Archdiocese of Hartford
- False claims: None reported

DELAWARE (2007-2009)

Delaware (2007-09) (2-year window)

- Population: 961,939
- No. survivors who filed claims under initial 2-year window: Approximately 175
- Under follow-up window for healthcare providers: Approximately 1,000 (claims solely against Pediatrician Dr. Earl V. Bradley, the most active previously undisclosed predator)
- Total no. Survivors who filed claims: 1,175 = 0.122% of population
- Entities sued under initial 2-year window: Archmere Academy, Inc., Boy Scouts, The Brothers of the Holy Cross, The Capuchin Friars, Catholic Diocese of Wilmington, Fairwinds Baptist Church, family members, Laurel School District, The Norbertine Fathers of Delaware, The Premonstratensian Fathers, Inc., Salesianum School, St. Edmond's Academy, St. Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Church, St. John the Beloved Church, Oblates of St. Francis de Sales
- Entities named under follow-up window: Beebe Medical Center (connected to Bradley), Medical Society of Delaware (connected to Bradley), Med. Soc. of Insurers Services
- False claims: None reported

GEORGIA (2015-2017)

Georgia (2015-17) (2-year window revives civil SOL against perpetrator (not entities), in effect 7/1/2015)

- Population: 10.43 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Approximately 20 = .0002% of population
- Predators identified: James S. Collins, current leading lobbyist and former Baptist Church and YMCA youth coordinator
- Entities identified but not sued due to narrow scope of window: Amateur Athletic Union, Boy Scouts, First Baptist Church of Vidalia, Pak Karate, Toombs County Church, US Taekwondo Association, The Darlington School in Rome, Archdiocese of Atlanta
- False claims: None reported

GUAM (2016)

Guam (2016 into the future) (open-ended window)

- Population: 164, 229
- No. survivors who filed claims: Approximately 200 = 0.122% of population
- Predators identified: Archbishop Anthony S. Apuron, Fr. Louis Brouillard, Fr. Rev. Antonio C. Cruz, Fr. Sigmund Hafemann, Rev. Louis William Rink, Edward Pereira, Fr. Juan Camacho, Fr. George Maddock, Gregory Seubert, Fr. Raymond Cepeda
- Entities sued: Archdiocese of Agana, Boy Scouts, Capuchin Order, Chalan Pago Parish, Mount Carmel Parish in Agat, Roman Catholic Church
- False claims: None reported

HAWAII (2012-2016)

Hawaii (2012-16) (2-year window with 2-year extension window, closed April 2016) (Re-opened window in 2018, currently open for civil lawsuits against perpetrators until July 1, 2020)

- Population: 1.43 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Approximately 206 = .014% of population
- Predators identified: Dr. Robert Browne, Fr. Francis Daubert, Fr. George DeCosta, Fr. Gerald Funcheon, Fr. Joseph Henry, Principal of Damien Memorial High School, Fr. William Queenan, Jay Ram (Big Island farmer who used California foster care system to import boys to abuse in 1980s/90s), Fr. Joseph Turk, Thomas G. Seifert, Dr. Robert M. Browne, Joseph Ferrario, Rob Wetzell, Fr. James Jackson, Arati Clarry
- Entities sued: Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America, Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, Congregation of Christian Bros. of Hawaii, Damien Memorial School, Diocese of Honolulu, Good Shepherd Church in Honouliuli on Hawaii Island, Hawaii School for the Deaf and Blind, Kamehameha Schools, Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers, Salvation Army, Society of Priests of St. Silpice, St. Anthony Parish of Kailua, St. Philomena Parish of Honolulu, St. Stephen Diocesan Seminary in Kaneohe, Boy Scouts of America, State Child Protective Services, Hawaii Preparatory Academy in Waimea
- False claims: None reported

MASSACHUSETTS (2014)

Massachusetts (2014 into the future) (revives civil SOL up to age 53 against perpetrator) (revives civil SOL with discovery +7 years against entities)

- Population: 6.86 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Revival of expired civil SOLs is ongoing (up to age cap)
- Predators identified: Fr. James Braley, Fr. Joseph Byrne, Darrell Croshier, Jr., Fr. Ross Frey, Ricardo Gonzalez, Fr. James MacGuinness, Domenic Previte, Jr., Monsignor Maurice Souza, Fr. Martin Walsh
- Entities sued: Archdiocese of Boston, Deerfield Academy, Diocese of Fall River, Diocese of Springfield, Diocese of Worcester, Fessenden School, Harvard University, St. Anthony's Church of East Falmouth
- False claims: None reported

MINNESOTA (2013-2016)

Minnesota (2013-16) (3-year window, closed May 2016)

- Population: 5.58 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Approximately 1006 = .018% of population
- Predators identified: 125+, Father Gerald "Jerry" Funcheon, Fr. James Thoennes, Jason McLean, Jay Ram, John Clark Donahue, Jacob Wetterling
- Entities sued: Archdiocese of St. Paul-Minneapolis, Boy Scouts of America, Children's Theatre Company, Dioceses of Crookston, New Ulm, St. Cloud, and Winona, Duluth Lutheran Church, YMCA, Pacific Southwest Region of United Synagogue Youth, Fruits of the Minnesota Window, St. John's Abbey, the Crosiers and the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate, Shattuck-St. Mary's, Mesabi Academy
- False claims: None reported

UTAH (2016)

Utah (2016) (window and retroactive extension to age 53 against perpetrators and aiders and abettors)

- Population: 3.1 million
- No. survivors who filed claims: Approximately 4 = .0001% of population
- Predators identified: Judge Roberts, Jesus Hurtado, Lyle Scott Mackay
- Entities identified but not sued due to narrow scope of window: LDS Church, Catholic Church, Boy Scouts of America
- False claims: None reported
