

ELIMINATING LIMITS TO JUSTICE FOR CHILD SEX ABUSE VICTIMS ACT OF 2022 (S. 3103)

CHILD USA celebrates the passage of the Eliminating Limits to Justice for Child Sex Abuse Victims Act of 2022 which will eliminate the statutes of limitations for the following claims, moving forward:

- Aggravated sexual abuse (with children under age 12)
- Sexual abuse
- Sexual abuse of a minor or ward
- Sexual exploitation of children
- Selling or buying of children
- Certain activities relating to material involving the sexual exploitation of minors
- Certain activities relating to material constituting or containing child pornography
- Production of sexually explicit depictions of a minor for importation into the US
- Forced labor
- Trafficking
- Sex trafficking of children
- Transportation (for prostitution or sexual activity)
- Coercion and enticement
- Transportation of minors (to engage in sexual conduct)

Victims whose above claims have not yet expired and those in the future will have as much time as they need to bring a claim.
