

# SUPREME COURT CASES SUPPORTING VACCINATION LAW

A state can impose “reasonable regulations” to protect public health, including a vaccination mandate, even when the regulation burdens individual rights.

***JACOBSON v. MASSACHUSETTS,***

"The right to practice religion freely does not include the right to expose the community or the child to communicable disease or the latter to ill-health or death."
